

Things to consider before signing up for a tree:

- You must be a Carteret Homeowner.
- The Borough will provide and plant the tree at no cost to the resident.
- Once the tree is planted, it cannot be moved or tampered with.
- Residents are responsible for watering and maintaining the tree.
- If the tree dies, the removal of the tree will be by or at the homeowner's expense.
- Trees can be planted either curbside or in the yard.
- Limited trees: requests will be responded to on a first come first serve basis.
- Forms must be completed & returned by April 15 th.
